The cost of each Spectacles camp is \$640. This includes housing on the Wesleyan College campus, three meals a day, classes and field trips. Tuition assistance is available to applicants if deposit is received by June 1, 2011. A \$75 deposit will be applied to the total camp cost and is non-refundable if cancelled after July 1.

Facilities

Spectacles will be held on the scenic campus of Wesleyan College in Macon, Georgia. Students will have the opportunity to explore math and science using the college's state-of-the-art science laboratories and computer facilities.

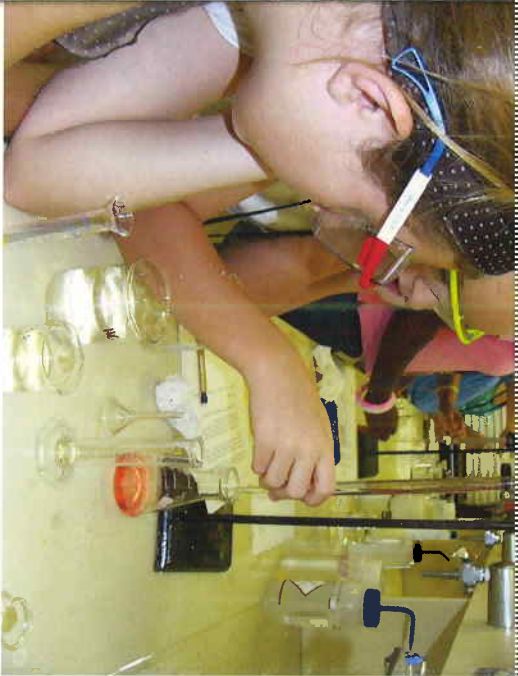
Students will be housed in the college's historic residence halls and will eat in the elegant Anderson Dining Hall. Facilities include an indoor swimming pool, gym and tennis courts.

Staff

Spectacles instructors are Wesleyan faculty members from the college's Division of Science and Mathematics. In addition, a camp Director and one resident assistant/camp counselor for every twelve students is present to maximize the camp experience. Resident assistants and the camp Director will live in the residence halls with the students and a certified lifeguard will be on duty during any scheduled pool activities.

Additional Opportunities

Students will participate in exciting field trips to a variety of places. Camp participants will be exposed to a diversity of career options by interacting with women scientists, mathematicians, engineers, doctors, architects, computer scientists and others.

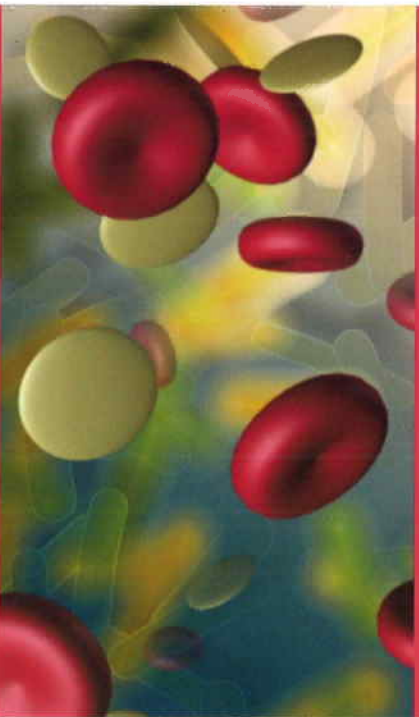
